Information regarding applying for a replacement trade certificate

A trade certificate is issued by the Western Australian Department of Training and Workforce Development when an individual has successfully completed a qualification; either through an apprenticeship training contract, or through a recognition of prior skills process conducted by a registered training provider.

Trade certificates issued for the successful completion of an apprenticeship in WA

If the original trade certificate is destroyed, lost or stolen, you can request a copy of your trade certificate or an extract of your training contract via the Western Australian Apprenticeship Management System (WAAMS) online client portal. Individuals can also confirm that you completed an apprenticeship through the WAAMS portal. User guides are available from the Apprenticeship Office website, which will provide you with more information on these options.

To obtain a paper-based trade certificate, complete the *Application for a replacement trade certificate* form, which includes a Statutory Declaration. This application must be completed in full and witnessed by a person authorised under the *Oaths, Affidavits and Statutory Declarations Act 2005* or *Statutory Declarations Act 1959 of the Commonwealth.*
